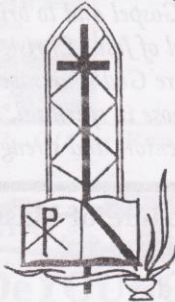

The following will serve as a guide. We recommend no household give less than \$5 per week. Please review the amount I/we give to the parish offertory and determine if the amount is sufficient considering all the gifts God has given us.
